



### **Fall 2024 Academic Period JD Student Dean's List**

January 15, 2025

The Dean's List is intended to recognize law students who perform at a superior level. JD students are eligible to be named to the Dean's List for the fall or spring semesters or the summer session, according to the criteria below. The rules are based on the student's enrollment for the term, not whether the student is enrolled in a full-time or part-time program.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- Earn a 3.00 (or higher) grade point average for the term;
- Complete 10 or more units for the term, of which 8 or more are letter-graded units, or;
- Complete 8-9 units for the term, of which 6 or more are letter-graded units;
- Have received no "I" (incomplete), "NC" (no credit), "NR" (not reported) grades for the term.

Only law school units are included in the Dean's List determination for JD/MBA students. Summer abroad program units are not included in the calculation of Dean's List eligibility. A notation will appear on the official transcripts of students named to the Dean's List.

If one or more of a student's grades is changed at a later date, such as an "I" to a letter grade, and the student wishes to be reevaluated for Dean's List, the student should contact the Registrar's Office at [lawreg@ggu.edu](mailto:lawreg@ggu.edu).
